Competitors will be required to assemble at the competition arena no later than 12:30pm on Saturday 10 October.

Entry Form

All competitions must complete an entry form available from the convenor.

Entrants will be asked to sign a “media release” declaration as the event will be photographed and used of a variety of social media platforms and for ongoing Picton Show, Australian Alpaca Association and Australian Alpaca Youth Promotions.

The Alpaca Schools Competition is for teams of 4 students – 2 Senior and 2 Junior to represent their high school at the Picton Show in Alpaca Junior & Senior Handling. Alpaca Handling is the only component for this competition at the Picton Show. Competition is open only to 5 team entries.

CONDITIONS

- Each school (High School) enters 1 team of 4 students. ie 2 Juniors (School Years 7-9) and 2 Seniors (School Years 10-12).
- A maximum of 5 teams only will be allowed to compete

- c) Alpacas will be provided by Storybook Alpacas on the day of competition for students to compete with.
- d) The 4 students will be judged individually in Alpaca Handling then all 4 scores combined to give a total score for their school.
- e) There will be a different course for Junior and Senior students, which will consist of a few basic obstacles that will demonstrate the handler's ability to control the alpaca. They may be required to let the alpaca go in an enclosed area and catch it again. The judge may also ask the students some very basic questions about alpacas and their fleece.
- f) Points will be given for each competitor out of 20, with a total possible score for each school of 80.
- g) Ribbons will be awarded to each placed team member with the winning school receiving an overall champion ribbon.
- h) Judging will be as per the Australian Alpaca Association rules for Youth Paraders – see <http://www.alpaca.asn.au/index.php/resources/educational-resources>
- i) Competitors must wear school agriculture uniform
