### Conditions of Entry:

- All cattle to be on the grounds by 8.30 am 8th of October 2022.
- Entries to be submitted by 01/10/2022 via google form located on the Facebook Page or emailed to [skye@shotgunlivestock.com](mailto:skye@shotgunlivestock.com)
- In accordance with all NSW Agricultural shows the following must be submitted via google form or email prior to the show:
  - National Cattle Health Declarations
  - Pesti Tests.
  - All exhibitors must sign an indemnity/waiver form.
- The age of cattle to be the actual age up to & inclusive of the 8th of October 2022.
- Calves at foot must not exceed 9 months of age on the 8th of October 2022.
- All exhibits must be registered with the appropriate Breed Societies.
- All breeds will be judged as their individual breeds, in alphabetical order. With 'any other small breeds' and 'any other large breeds' to be judged separately.
- All animals over 9 months MUST have a nose ring for bulls or nose grip for heifers.
- Bulls to be led by a person over 18 years old.
- Exhibitors to supply animal bedding.

Camping on the grounds on 07/10/22 is available at no extra cost. Camping equipment to be packed up by 7:30 am on 08/10/22. NO CAMPING 08/10/22.

**Breakfast & Lunch;** will be provided at no charge on the day.

- Breakfast at 7:30 am, sponsored by TBA

- Lunch after stud classes for 30 minutes, sponsored by TBA

### Presentation

**Classes:**

- To be judged as individual breeds (minimum 2 different studs represented to make a breed).
- All other breeds will be judged as 'Any Other Small Breed' & 'Any Other Large Breed'.

<b>Interbreed Steer Class</b>	
I1	Led Steer, not over 24 months and must still have milk teeth. (including ECM Livestock Junior Steer Competition)

<b>Interbreed Calf Class</b>	
I2	Champion Calf, not over 9 months (born no earlier than 08/01/22 inclusive).

<b>Interbreed Pair of Bulls (&lt;20 months)</b>	
I3	Pair of Junior Bulls. Bulls must be from the same breed, owned by the same exhibitor and not over 20 months.

<b>Interbreed Pair of Females (&lt;20 months)</b>	
I4	Pair of Junior Females. Females must be from the same breed, owned by the same exhibitor and not over 20 months.

<b>Interbreed Breeders Group</b>	
I5	Breeders Group. Exhibits must be owned and bred by the same exhibitor and represent each of the sexes (MMF/FFM).

<b>Youth Classes</b>
